The Culinary Arts Program of the Seacoast School of Technology is a two year, public high school program available to students from nearly 20 schools and 6 school districts in the New Hampshire Seacoast area. The goal of the program is to establish appreciation for the culinary arts and develop necessary skills and desire for students to go on to careers in culinary arts, by going on to college educations or directly into the culinary arts field.

Last year, through your generosity the Friends of SST Culinary Arts raised over \$18,000. With that money we were able to provide a video recording system that allows students to have access to a library of instructor demonstrations, support student attendance at a national culinary competition, provide a scholarship, and purchase a variety of culinary reference books and kitchen equipment. This is the only program in the state with this kind of community support.
