Confirmation letters will be sent in mid-May. The following camps will be offered on a first-come, first-served basis:

Computer Programming for Kids  
Week of July 6 Only

If you like Technology Fun Nights, you will love this. Learn to write computer programs and computer games using Throam (Programming language for kids) Python and PyGame and Visual Basic. You will learn the basics of computer programming, writing simple computer programs and creating your own video games. Limited to 20 students.

Learn to Be a Teacher  
Week of July 6 and Week of July 13

Do you take care of younger children? Do you want to know how to pick a story that is just right for a 3 year old? Do you want to learn how to make ooey-gooey recipes that young children love? Do you want to learn new games and songs? If you answered yes, sign up for summer camp at the Wright Start Preschool where you will learn how to make learning fun for young children!
