

Seacoast School of Technology Open House Wednesday, October 10th

All parents and community members are invited to meet the faculty and learn about the opportunities available through SST

The Seacoast School of Technology in Exeter will be holding its annual Open House on Wednesday, October 10, from 6:00 to 8:00 p.m. All parents, employers, and community members from SST's seven high schools are invited to meet with the teaching staff, tour the school, and learn about the 13 Career & Technical Education programs designed to assist high school students with their postsecondary plans. The Seacoast School of Technology provides career and technical education programs to students at Epping, Exeter, Newmarket, Raymond, Sanborn Regional, and Winnacunnet High Schools, as well as the Great Bay E-Learning Charter School. The Open House also provides an excellent opportunity for junior high and middle school parents and students to learn about how a career and technical education program can be part of their high school plans.

This year the SST Open House will feature a new format. Parents and visitors may meet with teachers and tour SST's classrooms and labs between 6:00 – 7:00 pm. At 7:00 pm, all Open House visitors will attend a presentation by the SST Administration in the Talbot Gymnasium at the Seacoast School of Technology. This session is designed to give parents and students the opportunity to ask questions about programs, policies & procedures, postsecondary & scholarship opportunities, the SST internship/work-based learning program, and an update on the SST renovation project. The information session will highlight Project Running Start. This opportunity, offered in conjunction with the Community College System of New Hampshire, allows SST students in Health Sciences, Animal & Plant Science, Early Childhood Education, Digital Communications, Computer Programming, Culinary Arts, Marketing Education, Automotive Technologies, Biotechnology and Pre-Engineering to earn college credit along with their SST Certificate. Following these sessions, Open House visitors may continue their informal tours of the Seacoast School of Technology and visit with SST administration, teachers, and staff.

Programs offered at SST include Biotechnology, Automotive Technologies, Welding Technologies, Animal & Plant Science, Building Construction Technologies, Marketing Education, Early Childhood Education, Culinary Arts, Health Sciences & Technologies, Computer Programming, Digital Communications, Pre-Engineering and Technology Careers. The Seacoast School of Technology is located at 40 Linden Street in Exeter. Open House guests are asked to park behind SST using the former Tuck High School driveway or behind the former Exeter High School Annex using the Annex driveway on Linden Street.
